UK Waste Regulations place a duty onto businesses or organisations that produce or handle waste to attempt to prevent it and to apply the waste hierarchy when transferring it.



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Regulation 4 of the Control of Asbestos Regulations states that landlords or duty holders have the responsibility to manage asbestos containing materials (ACMs).

An asbestos management survey provides information on any asbestos identified, its condition and how it should be managed, i.e. labelled, encapsulated or removed and this forms part of your Asbestos Register.

Management surveys cover you for normal occupancy and maintenance but if you are planning to have building work carried out in your premises you must have a more invasive inspection, called a Refurbishment Survey.

Where part or all of a building is to be demolished you must have a  $\mbox{Demolition Survey}.$

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#### Asbestos Removals



The normal recommendation for asbestos containing materials (ACMs) that are identified during the course of a survey and that are likely to be disturbed during refurbishment work is to remove them altogether.

For higher risk materials, such as asbestos insulating board (AIB), lagging, insulation and sprayed coatings, removals must be carried out by a licensed contractor. This is because they have the potential to release larger amounts of fibre than lower risk materials such as asbestos cement.

The method for removing asbestos will differ depending on the material that contains it and how it has been applied. In most cases the area where work is to be carried out will need to be sealed off and the air flow controlled. This normally involves construction of an airtight enclosure and use of specialist air pumps and filters. The operatives themselves will wear special overalls and breathing apparatus and must go through careful procedures to decontaminate themselves when leaving the enclosure.

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### Soft-Strip



Soft strip works are conducted prior to demolition, refurbishment or remodelling of a building. The intention is normally to leave nothing but the steel frame/shell and involves removal of all non-structural elements of the interior and exterior, including:

Fixtures & fittings (doors, windows, bathroom & kitchen fittings), internal High levels of noise are often unavoidable but RJS Waste can work with the walls, ceilings, temporary structures, equipment and machinery

The works have the potential to produce high levels of dust and noise so careful planning is required to reduce this. This includes limiting the number of people in the work area, screening work areas, use of RPE (Respiratory Protective Equipment) and suppressing dust using water.

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### **Demolition**



Demolition is covered by the Building Act 1984 and all works must comply with the Construction (Design and Management) Regulations 2015. Before starting the demolition a health & safety plan must be produced by the principal contractor and notification given to the local authority.

Careful planning is essential to identify factors such as the size and position of the building, access and the surrounding areas, construction style of the building (steel or concrete framed, brick built etc) and the

materials comprising the structure. Consideration has to be taken for whether hazardous materials such as asbestos are present. The building may also require a soft strip to remove all non structural elements.

All jobs will have a Method Statement & Risk Assessment compiled to ensure that works are carried out safely and efficiently.

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#### **Chemical Waste**



Hazardous waste is that which contains substances or has properties that might be harmful to human health or to the environment. This may be immediate or over an extended period.

These substances are categorised according to how dangerous they are. They can be either, very toxic, toxic, harmful, corrosive or irritant.

Chemicals that fit into this category and for which special measures should

be taken include:

Paints, Adhesives, Solvents, Detergents, Cleaning Products Fertilisers, Lubricants, Varnishes, Pesticides, Thinners

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### Fly-Tipped Waste Collection



In recent years the number of fly-tipping incidents has soared due to a rise in landfill tax for the disposal of waste and a significant increase in waste collections by non-licensed personnel.

It is a crime to illegally dump waste due to the negative effect that it can have on the environment. Syringes, chemical waste and other toxic wastes can present a risk to human health and can harm wildlife and farm animals. This might be from direct contact on the site of the fly-tipped

waste or by the waste getting into a nearby water source. Things like furniture and tyres can be a fire hazard in wooded areas.

The dumping of waste also affects the appeal of an area and can have a detrimental impact on future investment within that area. This criminal act can spoil our neighbourhoods and quality of life for children playing in these areas.

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#### WEEE Waste Collection



The main aim of the WEEE Directive is to encourage the recycling and reuse of electrical and electronic waste and by doing this it hopes to reduce the amount that is produced.

Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) contains significant amounts of precious metals and halogenated substances and by recycling and reusing it we can significantly reduce the requirement for extraction of new raw materials and thus reduce the impact on the environment.

WEEE is in the top five growing waste streams within the UK and currently produces up to one million tonnes per year, with this figure set to rise substantially within the next decade.
